State Services & Resources

- **Maryland Relay**
 - If you need relay services and telecommunications equipment, you may receive them free of charge from Maryland Relay. Website: doit.maryland.gov/mdrelay.
- **Maryland Commission on Civil Rights (MCCR)**
 - MCCR oversees the enforcement of Maryland's laws against discrimination in employment, housing, public accommodations, and state contracts. If you experience discrimination in the state of Maryland, you may file a complaint with MCCR. Website: mccr.maryland.gov.
- **Department of Health (MDH)**
 - MDH has four administrations and numerous programs that promotes and improves the health and safety of all Marylanders through disease prevention, access to care, quality management, and community engagement. Website: health.maryland.gov.
- **Office of Health Care Quality (OHCQ)**
 - OHCQ monitors the quality of care in Maryland's health care facilities and community-based programs. If you experience discrimination in health care, you may file a complaint with OHCQ. Website: health.maryland.gov/ohcq.
- **Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA)**
 - DDA provides support and focuses on self-determination, self-advocacy, supporting families, housing, and employment for people with developmental disabilities. Website: dda.health.maryland.gov.
- **Department of Aging (MDOA)**
 - MDOA provides advocacy and services for all older adults. Website: aging.maryland.gov.
- **Maryland Department Of Disabilities (MDOD)**
 - MDOD coordinates and improves the delivery of services to individuals with disabilities in the state of Maryland. Website: mdod.maryland.gov.
- **Division of Rehabilitation Services (DORS)**
 - The DORS Deaf and Hard of Hearing services section is also known as vocational rehabilitation (VR) counselors that provides assistance in finding jobs and providing accommodations. Website: dors.maryland.gov/consumers/specialized/deaf.
